## Taking “Next Steps” after MissionConnexion Southwest

The world’s problems can seem overwhelming and daunting at times. As followers of Jesus, we desire to jump in and serve but many times we struggle with questions of where do I serve? How? What capacity? Will I have enough time? Can I use my work-related skills and gifts to bless others? This conference is designed with the desire to help you to have clarity and discernment in where you believe God may be leading you.

Some people are here, sure of their missions-related role and that is great as well. We hope you find a number of resources to help you on your journey. Others are not sure of what their role is at this stage of life, and for the future.

Those of us working together for this conference are committed to see tangible, God-honoring results. We have been praying regularly that God would use this time to speak to you and that you would then take the “next steps” as a result of this time together.

**We have identified six areas of missions-related roles that are possible “next steps”:**

- **Goer, Sender, Welcomer, Mobilizer, Pray-er and Learner.** In order to make this as practical as possible we have scheduled a session for each person to attend a workshop on one of these six areas, 5:30 to 6:30 Saturday afternoon.

Our prayer and desire is that each person would be seeking God’s direction while going through the various sessions of this conference, giving some prayerful thought to which of those six sessions would be the best one to be part of.

More will be explained during the conference, and included here are some questions that may help in determining possible “*next steps*”:

### **Am I a Goer?**

- With a willingness to humble myself, to learn how to lovingly and sacrificially cross cultures to live in such a way so others can hear the good news of Jesus, being passionate for the cause of Christ, purposeful and determined to be obedient no matter what the cost and willing to prepare well.

**Location: 4th Grade Room**

### **Am I a Sender?**

- With a great concern for the lost of this world, a desire to use my resources to see people be sent to share the gospel. A willingness to learn to sacrifice in order that the good news of Jesus’ love and redemption can be sent out around the world.

**Location: 5-6 Graders Room**

### **Am I a Welcomer?**

- With a passion to engage with people who are coming to America from other cultures, to see this as a way to show the love of Jesus and to share with them the plan of salvation, to commit my time and energy to these relationships, seeing this as the same level of commitment made by those called to minister in another country and culture?

**Location: High School Room**

### **Am I a Mobilizer?**

- With a great desire to help people find their calling, encourage others, help them with guidance, direction, a listening ear, willing to pray with them and for them, and to stand with them in their difficulties and their victories. To help see the local church mobilized into greater service for the Kingdom of God.

**Location: Kindergarten Room**

### **Am I a Pray-er?**

- With a God-given passion to pray for the unreached, to pray for more workers for the harvest, to pray for the workers I know of, to pray for God’s will to be done on earth, with a willingness to make prayer a priority time commitment?

**Location: Worship Center East Side**

### **Am I a Learner?**

- With a sense that God is leading me to a future Great Commission role but realizing that right now I need to be serious about deepening my relationship with Jesus, about studying and learning from the Word of God, and I need to learn what God is doing in the world today and seek what role he has for me to reach the unreached for Christ?

**#16 : Azmera Global**

Azmera is about: Keeping global workers healthy and on the field and Helping global senders stay engaged. At Azmera our goal is to be a part of nurturing and impacting cross-cultural global workers from various nations already in the harvest field, so that they can serve God and others to their fullest potential and remain faithful to their calling overseas, resulting in more people coming to a saving knowledge of Christ. We do this mainly through hosting 3-5 International Haven Retreats a year. At these haven retreats, workers are given the opportunity to rest, commune with God, and connect with others. At each haven retreat, we are "Wow'd again!" by they ways God specifically works in many women's lives in a few day. We take a team of volunteers from the States to make this happen. **#23 : Beyond**

We catalyze Disciple Making Movements to transform Unreached People Groups. We launch apostolic teams to equip everyday men, women and children to disciple their own people directly, quickly and exponentially. Lives and whole communities are transformed by disciples making disciples in what can only be called a movement of God.

**#6 : Christar**

Christar exists to cultivate Christ-honoring transformation in communities where He is yet to be worshiped. Specifically, Christar focuses on the least-reached regions of the world—areas where people have no access to a church that both presents the gospel in their language and worships using their cultural forms. Building on a heritage of over 110 years of church-planting experience, Christar workers seek to have a Christ-honoring influence in least-reached communities at large while sharing the good news of Jesus with people who've never heard.

**#35 : Crossworld**

Crossworld is a global mission agency, a formative community of disciple-makers from all professions bringing God's love to life in the world's least-reached marketplaces. Formed as a missionary sending organization in 1931 under the name Unevangelized Fields Missions (UFM), Crossworld currently has approximately 350 workers in over 30 countries engaged in disciple-making through medicine, education, business, sports, translation, and many other professions.

**#4 : Dakar Academy Schools**

Dakar Academy was established in 1961 for missionary kids in a one room schoolhouse. Since that time have grown to a full Pre-K-12 Campus with an additional campus K-8. We opened two homeschool co-ops in hard to serve areas in West Africa in the last two years and are opening our 3rd campus serving K-8 in Fall of 2022. Our mission statement is "So All Can Serve" and we strive to live that out practically. We believe that the gospel spreads where schools are present because missionaries are able to have educational options for their children and pursue the work God has called them to do as they evangelize and spread the gospel. Our heart is to share how God can use those He calls to combine their passion for teaching with a heart to serve internationally.

**#51 : Engineering Ministries International**

EMI is a ministry that designs facilities that serve the poor in developing countries. These facilities (incl. hospitals, orphanages, schools, clean water projects & more) directly impact communities by meeting physical needs and communicating God's love in a practical way. We partner with Christian workers, pastors, and other non-profits who have a vision to help the poor and preach the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Since 1982, we've worked on over 2,000 relief and development projects in 100+ countries. From our offices around the world, over 200 staff and interns labor to bring the Gospel to the poorest and least reached peoples on earth.

**#11 : Ethnos 360**

Ethnos360 is committed to reaching the unreached and least-reached peoples of the world. Our goal is to see a thriving indigenous church for every people, with the Scriptures translated into their heart language. Ethnos360 offers a comprehensive training program designed to equip and prepare missionaries for longer terms of service, as well as opportunities to minister shorter term as teachers, accountants, and various other ministries. Short-term trips, including Wayumi in Pennsylvania or Interface in Papua New Guinea, give exposure to realities of life on the mission field and why missions is so important.

**#52 : Free Wheelchair Ministries**

Free Wheelchair Mission is a humanitarian, faith-based, nonprofit organization that provides wheelchairs at no cost to people with disabilities living in developing nations. In collaboration with a network of like-minded partners, FWM has been providing wheelchairs to those in need around the world since 2001, providing dignity, independence and hope through the gift of mobility.

**#7 : Frontiers USA**
